



Q2 Please tell us which GP practice you are registered with:



Q3 How long does it usually take you to travel to your GP practice? (Please select one option)





Q4 What is the maximum distance you would you be willing to travel for a face-to-face appointment outside of usual opening hours? (Please select one option)





Q5 What is the maximum amount of time you would be willing to travel for a face-to-face appointment outside of usual opening hours? (please select one option)





Q6 When would be best for you to access routine non-urgent general practice services outside of usual opening hours?






Q8 How important is it for you to have access to the below services outside of usual practice opening hours? (Please rank them 1 being most preferred to 7 being least preferred)


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Q9 Which practice staff would it be helpful for you to be able access outside of usual practice opening hours? (Please select options that apply)





Q10 How would you like to book your appointment in the evening or at the weekend? (Please select options that apply)










Q14 What age group do you belong to?

Q15 Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?





Q17 What is your ethnic group? (Choose one option)





Q19 Which of the following options best describes your sexual orientation?




