




Q3 How long does it usually take you to travel to your GP practice? (Please select one option)







Q4 What is the maximum distance you would you be willing to travel for a face-to-face appointment outside of usual opening hours? (Please select one option)





Q5 What is the maximum amount of time you would be willing to travel for a face-to-face appointment outside of usual opening hours? (please select one option)






Q7 How would you prefer to access GP services outside of the usual opening hours? (Please rank them 1 being most preferred to 5 being least preferred)


Q8 How important is it for you to have access to the below services outside of usual practice opening hours? (Please rank them 1 being most preferred to 7 being least preferred)








Q10 How would you like to book your appointment in the evening or at the weekend? (Please select options that apply)


Q11 If your GP practice has no further appointments at a time convenient to you, what do you normally do?




Q14 What age group do you belong to?


Q15 Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?





Q18 What is your gender?



Q19 Which of the following options best describes your sexual orientation?



Q20 What is your religion?


